



Bathroom Lighting

Ideal lighting in a bathroom comes from two different directions. Lighting should be in front of you either above the mirror or on either side of the mirror. Also, behind you, in the ceiling, a flush piece or a chandelier, depending on the height of the ceiling is advisable.

Light coming from in front of you and behind you illuminates the shadow effect on your face.

Recessed lighting in the bathroom should be used sparingly. It tends to create shadows if used over the sink area.

Of course, recessed lighting in the shower area is advisable.
